



## Letter of Agreement for Participation in Practicum Program (FMAP)

### Conditions of Application for Participants FMAP 2010

1. Candidates for the FMAP program must submit a complete application based on the guidelines of the application instructions.
2. All applicants must attend an interview (conference call), conducted in English and Spanish, with a Fundación de la Lengua Representative. Because the interview is an integral part of the application process, the Fundación de la Lengua Española reserves the right to reject or cancel your participation due to failure to attend the interview, or false representation during the interview.
3. Applications will not be considered for review until all original materials are complete and have been received by the Fundación de la Lengua office.
4. The FLE considers each application on an individual basis and the FLE carefully reviews all materials to determine whether each candidate meets the necessary qualifications for participation in the program.
5. All the applicants must submit the following information:
  - ✓ Copy of your passport
  - ✓ Flight reservation
  - ✓ Reference letter from a professor at your School
  - ✓ Application form
  - ✓ Letter of understanding
6. Participants are advised to purchase their own flight tickets to Spain only after they have been confirmed to participate in the program. We recommend making a tentative flight reservation. No compensation for travel costs, visa fees, or other costs incurred by the participant shall be provided by FLE under any circumstances of cancellation.
7. All participants will travel under the tourist legal status. Due to the fact that the program is an opportunity to practise the language skills and there is no economical compensation, the applicants do not need any kind of visa.
8. By signing below, I accept and understand the terms and conditions of participating in the FMAP Program. I understand that FLE is a nonprofit organization that aims to facilitate greater understanding between cultures. I understand that as an FMAP participant I am expected to uphold the mission and purpose of the program in my daily participation.
9. I confirm that I am available for placement at a school, without restriction for a ten or twelve week commitment. I am available to fly to Spain on the 12<sup>th</sup> of January, 2010. In committing to these dates I have taken into account school dates, employment commitments, family events and all other considerations. I understand that any additional days in Spain are separate to my FMAP commitment.
